Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in a case arising out of FIR No.299 dated 19.07.2016, registered at Police Station Model Town, Rewari, who has been booked for having committed offence punishable under Section 306 IPC (Section 201 IPC added later).

At the very outset, learned State counsel, on instructions from S.I. Raj Singh, has informed that in pursuance of order dated 21.09.2016 of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation on 16.12.2016 and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage. Moreover, no suicide note recovered from the petitioner.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 21.09.2016, passed by this Court whereby the ad-interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
