It is contended that petitioner No.1 – Narinder Kaur Gill, aged about 40 years, a divorcee, has got married with petitioner No.2 Jaspreet Singh, aged about 21 years, against wishes of their family members, arrayed as private respondents No. 4 to 6, for the reason that it is an inter-caste marriage Now the petitioners apprehend danger to their lives and liberty at the hands of such private respondents, as such to seek protection in that regard, they have approached this Court by way of filing the present petition.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent

No.2 – SSP, Moga, to look into the grievances of the petitioners and to take necessary measures to ensure that lives and liberty of the petitioners are not jeopardized at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6 or persons claiming under them.

However, this order shall not validate the marriage between the petitioners and shall not have any effect on any civil or criminal action to which the petitioners may be found liable, under the law.
