This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.330 dated 19.09.2016, under Sections 341, 323, 324, 325, 427, 506, 148, 149, 201 of IPC (Section 308 of IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station, City Sangrur.

During the course of arguments today, learned State counsel has clarified that the petitioner had been implicated on the statement of main accused Amritpal Singh Sekhon. That apart during the course of investigation in which the petitioner had duly associated, he has disclosed the individual roles of all the accused. As per his own disclosure, the petitioner is attributed baseball bat blows upon Karanvir Singh and Balwinder Singh and such injuries have been opined to be simple in nature.

That apart as per disclosure of main accused Amritpal Singh Sekhon, the present petitioner was stated to be present at the spot and armed

is stated to have already joined investigation.

Under such circumstances, the prayer made in the present petition is accepted.

Petitioner is directed to cooperate in the investigation process.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
