Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.48 dated 12.07.2015 under Sections 302, 323, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh, states that in the aforesaid FIR, prosecution has already examined as many as 24 witnesses out of total 26 witnesses and, therefore, trial is at advance stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the fact that the trial is at advance stage, no case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, present petition is dismissed.

However, trial Court is directed to expedite the trial.
