This is a petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.81 dated 30.07.2016 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 494, 420, 323, 506 and 120-B read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC'), at Police Station Jaito, District Faridkot and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 24.04.2017 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Vide order dated 05.09.2017 the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for getting their statements recorded. Report of the trial Court dated 21.10.2017 was received according to which the parties did not appear before the learned trial Court. On 26.10.2017, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioners and report regarding compromise was sought for 07.11.2017. On 06.11.2017, it was again reported that none of the parties appeared for recording their statements.

Today also there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners. The quashing of the FIR was sought on the ground that the parties have compromised the matter. However, keeping in view the fact that the parties have not appeared before the Court below to get their statements recorded with regard to the veracity of the compromise, no case for quashing of the instant FIR on the basis of compromise is made out at this stage.

Dismissed.
