ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.66 dated 04.05.2014, under Sections 279, 337, 338 & 427 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that FIR is a result of road accident in which injuries were sustained by the complainant. He further contends that the accident had taken place without any fault of either of the parties and therefore, the matter has been compromised with the complainant.

This Court by the order dated 05.09.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of JMIC, Kharar, dated 11.09.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated

that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is outcome of some misunderstanding, which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466***, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.66 dated 04.05.2014, under Sections 279, 337, 338 & 427 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner(s).
