Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

This is a petition for grant of regular bail in FIR No.252 dated 25.09.2015, under Sections 384 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Sections 364-A, 365, 420, 511, 149, 120-B of IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act, 1959 added later on), registered at Police Station Patran, District Patiala.

Learned State counsel submits that as per the last order dated 08.02.2017, witnesses were produced before the Court on 20.02.2017 and they were examined in examination-in-chief and then the case posted for 21.02.2017, but Parveen Kumar another accused, remained absent on both the dates. According to her, Parveen Kumar has been sending medical certificates to seek adjournment. Now the matter is fixed for 10.03.2017. Trial Court has issued non-bailable warrants.

In that view of the matter, petition stands disposed of. Trial Court shall not release the said person Parveen Kumar on bail till the trial is completed and complete the trial in any case before 15.04.2017.
