Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Amrik Singh, Police Station, Lambi, District Sr. Muktsar Sahib submits that in compliance of orders dated 05.09.2017 the petitioners have since joined the investigation and that nothing is to be recovered from them and has not opposed the grant of bail to the petitioners.
