This order will dispose of third application for grant of regular bail filed by the petitioner.

The petitioner along with 19-20 other co-accused had allegedly waylaid complainant Baljit Singh, Lal Singh, Avtar Singh, Surjit Singh and 4-5 other persons and inflicted injuries to them. So far as the petitioner is concerned, he has been attributed *gandasi* blows on the head of injured Lal Singh.

The petitioner has been in custody with effect from 08.11.2015. Petitioner had been granted interim bail for a period of two months for getting himself treated for the cervical spondylitis. He has surrendered after availing the interim bail.

Medical report regarding the injuries on the person of injured Lal Singh has been produced indicating that he is well oriented to TPP and is conscious.

An application under Section 319 Cr.P.C filed by the

prosecution agency has been allowed and the witnesses are to be re-examined.

Taking into consideration the fact that the injured stands discharged from the hospital and the petitioner has been in custody since 08.11.2015; likelihood of the trial not to be concluded in near future, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that petitioner will not indulge into any act of threatening the witnesses or tampering with the evidence.
