Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.45 dated 26.04.2016, under Sections 420/406/120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rup-Nagar.

Suffice it to notice that FIR has been registered at the instance of Tarsem Singh who is none other than the brother-in-law of the present petitioner. Allegations are that the complainant and also one Jalla Singh having been duped a sum of Rs.4 lakhs on the pretext of being sent abroad.

Petitioner was arrested on 30.11.2016.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan has already been presented.

Trial would take some time to conclude. Offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate.

Without making any observations on merits and keeping in view the length of incarceration already suffered, petitioner is held entitled

to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Rup-Nagar.
