Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.50 dated 10.04.2016 under Sections 279, 337, 338 and 427 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Division-B, District Amritsar, on the basis of compromise dated 10.04.2016 (Annexure-P4).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 22.09.2016, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties appeared before the Judicial

statements for compromise. Report bearing No.271 dated 08.11.2016 from the concerned Magistrate duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar vide Endst. No.12670-R dated 10.11.2016 has also been received.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, the compromise between the parties is without any pressure, duress, inducement and threat of any kind from any corner voluntarily with their free will.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.50, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
