Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.22 dated 26.02.2012 registered under Sections 323, 452, 379, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur, on the basis of compromise Annexure-P2.

On presentation of the petition, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

In compliance of the order dated 05.09.2017, the parties had appeared before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur on 13.09.2017

and got recorded their statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide letter bearing No.911 dated 14.09.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur vide letter bearing No.16010/RKT dated 15.09.2017.

According to the report of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur, the parties have compromised the matter amicably with their free will and without any pressure from any corner.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.22, is hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
