The instant petition under Section 439 Cr. P.C. has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR no. 21 dated 24.03.2017, under Section 8 of POSCO Act and u/s 506 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell Panipat, Distt. Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contented that the petitioner is in custody since 24.03.2017, and the challan has been presented. The evidence of prosecutrix has been recorded. He prays that the petitioner be released on regular bail.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State vehemently opposes the grant of regular bail.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 24.03.2017, no useful purpose would be served by

keeping the petitioner incarcerated and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is accepted. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
