The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking bail in case FIR No.430 dated 17.05.2017 registered under Sections 376 and 506 IPC at Police Station Model Town, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in fact, the complainant came to the house of Seema, sister of the petitioner after she was thrown out of the matrimonial home after administering beating. The incident in question took place on 14.05.2017 whereas, the complaint was lodged after unexplained delay of three days on 17.05.2017. The petitioner is in custody since 19.05.2017.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application.

Heard.

As per the FIR, the petitioner called the prosecutrix on her mobile phone and asked her to meet him and threatened her that in case of refusal, he would kill her daughter. The petitioner took the prosecutrix in a car to the house of his sister Seema where he committed rape upon her. In the statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C, the prosecutrix had stated that the petitioner made relations with her forcibly.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the allegations, no case for grant of concession of regular bail is made out.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed.
