Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.97 dated 28.06.2015 under Sections 307/324/323/452/148/149 IPC (Sections 307 and 452 IPC deleted lateron and Section 427 IPC added lateron, in report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. and Section 307 IPC added lateron by allowing the application under Section 216 Cr.P.C. by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana), registered at Police Station Model Town, District Ludhiana City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 06.09.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulwinder Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 06.09.2017 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
