Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P. C., the petitioners seek the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 19, dated 04.08.2016, registered under Sections 326, 323, 324, 427 and 34 IPC, at Police Station Narot Jaimal Singh, District Pathankot.

The present petition had been filed on behalf of three petitioners which now survives only qua petitioners No. 1 and 2 since as per the statement made by learned State counsel in Court today, petitioner No. 3 has been declared innocent by the investigating agency.

Vide order dated 22.09.2016, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had ordered petitioners No. 1 and 2 to surrender before the Court below which shall release them on interim bail to its satisfaction.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Pawan Kumar, submits that the petitioners No. 1 and 2 have joined investigation and at this stage are not needed for further questioning.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed qua petitioners No. 1 and 2 subject to the conditions prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Nothing observed herein-above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the case.
