Notice of motion to the official respondents.

On the asking of Court, Mr. H.S. Grewal, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Let a copy of the paper book be supplied to him.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P1) within the framework of law expeditiously, preferably within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. The official respondents shall also ensure that the petitioner is not unduly put to harassment by repeatedly calling him to the Police Station or the office of senior police officers or visiting the house of the petitioner, and in case the petitioner is required in any complaint a clear seven days' notice be given to him to enable him to have his legal recourse.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not come in the way of any recourse to law so adopted by the authorities.
