Allegations against the petitioner Amrik Singh in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No378 dated 17.7.2017 registered at Police Station Sadar, Thanesar, District Kurukshetra under Section 18 of the NDPS Act, are that on 17.7.2017 from his conscious possession 460 grams of opium non-commercial quantity was recovered.

Contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner are that the petitioner is behind the bars since 17.7.2017 and trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars.

The factual scenario could not be displaced by learned State counsel.

In the light of submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and the fact that the trial will take a long time to conclude, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the petitioner in the present case is unwarranted. Accordingly, he is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Kurukshetra.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
