KULDIP SINGH, J. (Oral)

In compliance with the order dated 12.09.2017 passed by this Court, learned counsel for the respondent has brought two demand drafts bearing No. 502854 dated 07.10.2017 and 017551 dated 10.10.2017 amounting to ₹2,96,000/- and ₹3,00,000/- respectively total of which comes to ₹5,96,000/- . The original demand drafts have been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner in the Court and the photocopies of the same have been retained for record. In this way, entire amount of ₹9,96,000/- has been paid to the petitioner.

The prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondent No. 1 to 3 to take appropriate action against respondents No. 4 and 5 for cheating an NRI for ₹9,96,000/-.

Learned State counsel has stated that the SHO, NRI Wing, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali has been recommended that an FIR to be registered against the respondents No. 4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner will not pursue the said case as entire payment has been made to the petitioner.

In view of the matter, the State is directed not to register the FIR against respondent No. 4 and 5as the matter has been amicably settled.

Since, the entire amount in question has been returned by the respondents No. 4 and 5, therefore, the present petition becomes infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
