**Criminal Misc. No.M-32844 of 2017**

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.66 dated 12.05.2016 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Division No.2, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 04.08.2017 and though there are other cases pending against him, the detail of which has been furnished by way of CRM-38610-

2017, but in all those cases, he is on bail. He further submits that so far as

FIR No.08 dated 12.01.2008 under Sections 382/342/323/506 IPC, P.S. Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib is concerned, the petitioner is on bail in that case also.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate in Court and does not dispute the submissions made on behalf the petitioner.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that in all the cases registered against the petitioner, he is on bail and in the present case, he is in custody since 04.08.2017 and trial in the case shall take long time, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his heavy bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

If the petitioner is found indulged in any other case, the prosecution shall be at liberty to seek cancellation of his bail.

It is made clear that the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as any expression on the merits of the case.
