Petitioners seek regular bail in FIR No.84 dated 14.05.2017, under Sections 365, 323, 325 & 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Radaur, Yamuna Nagar.

The petitioners were arrested on 20.07.2017 and 11.07.2017 respectively and are in jail since then. Looking to the offence in which the petitioners seek bail, it is clear that the offence under Section 365 of IPC is triable by the Magistrate. Challan having been filed, it is of no use keeping the petitioners in detention as under trial since the trial will take its own time.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed.

Petitioners shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the

Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioners shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
