The allegations against the petitioner in this regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. are that on 21.03.2017, the petitioner along with his co-accused-non-applicants-Gopal and Vikas attacked Deepak-Complainant and co-accused like to have fired three shots leading to the registration of FIR and arrest on 18.04.2017.

The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner has not attributed any role and that his co-accused Gopal who is the principal accused has been allowed bail vide order of this Court in CRM-35403-2017.

The factual scenario is not disputed by the learned State counsel, who had stoutly opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner on the ground of seriousness of the offence.

However, appreciating these submissions, in the light of contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner that the principal accused

has since been released on bail and the fact that culpability, if any, shall be determined at the trial coupled with the fact that the trial will take a long time to conclude, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the petitioner in the present case is not warranted. Accordingly, he is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, .

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
