ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in the FIR No.06 dated 06.01.2015, under Sections 420,406, 467, 471, 506 & 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Bahin, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that the petitioner had obtained a loan from the Rural Bank, Kondal for an amount of Rs.4.5 lacs for the purchase of tractor but he had furnished a copy of the registration certificate of a motorcycle instead of tractor to the Bank. He also states that the petitioner has already repaid an amount of Rs.7.66 lacs to the Bank against the loan of Rs.4.5 lacs.

This Court, by the order dated 06.09.2017, had directed the petitioner to join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged

under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI SI Durga Parshad, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 06.09.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
