SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J.(ORAL)

The petitioners originally prayed for issuance of directions to the official respondents to register criminal cases against the private respondents for the incident that allegedly took place on 24th July, 2015. They had also sought protection of their life and liberty from the hands of the private respondents.

Perused the reply by way of an affidavit filed on behalf of the official respondents No.2 and 3, in which it has been made out that no effective action on the petitioners' complaint submitted earlier was warranted in view of the fact that the dispute between them and the private respondents is basically civil in nature over the issue of land/landed property. Admittedly, the civil suit between the rival side of private parties is pending and the petitioners claim that an order for *status quo* has been passed in their favour by the Ld. Civil Court.

In view of the above circumstances, the matter is disposed off with direction upon respondents No.2 and 3 to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners/their family members is protected from the hands of the private respondents, and that no breach of peace is allowed to take place at the disputed land.
