Petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.49 dated 26.05.2017, under Section 376, 452 IPC, registered at Police Station Chhattiwind, District Amritsar.

It is submitted that the petitioner and the complainant's daughter solemnized marriage on 02.07.2017 against the wishes of the complainant. Petitioner and his wife are living together in peace and harmony at their matrimonial home. A criminal complaint (Annexure P-2) has been filed by the complainant's daughter against her own parents. Her statement in the said complaint is attached as Annexure P-3 with this petition. Moreover, the petitioner has joined investigation and he undertakes to face proceedings. It is thus prayed that this petition be allowed.

Learned counsel for the complainant opposes this petition but is unable to deny the factum of marriage between the petitioner and

complainant's daughter or of their living together thereafter.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Parshotam Singh, verifies that the petitioner and the complainant's daughter are living together after solemnization of marriage on 02.07.2017. It is further verified that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the interim order passed by this Court. He is not involved in any other criminal case.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioner is likely to abscond.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, but without commenting upon or expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. Consequently, order dated 03.11.2017, is made absolute.
