It is contended that petitioner No.1 – Ramandeep Kaur aged about 20 years, has got married with petitioner No.2 – Gurpreet Singh, aged about 25 years, against wishes of her family members, arrayed as respondents No. 4 and 5, who were opposed to the marriage and are threatening to interfere in their marital life, therefore, necessary protection be granted to them.

At this stage, Respondent No.4 – Jaswinder Singh has appeared alongwith his counsel Mr. Sanjeev K. Virk, Advocate. Respondent No.4 - Jaswinder Singh states that neither he nor his wife Kulwinder Kaur - respondent No.5, or any of their family members have any objection to the marriage. They have neither interfered in

the marital life of the petitioner nor would they do so.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that private respondents had assaulted the petitioners yesterday, regarding which the matter was reported to the police and the petitioners have got an apprehension that they may be attacked by the private respondents or persons claiming under them, again.

Under these circumstances, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 – SSP, Patiala, to look into the grievances of the petitioners and to take necessary measures to ensure that lives and liberty of the petitioners are not jeopardized at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5 or persons claiming under them.

However, this order shall not validate the marriage between the petitioners and shall not have any effect on any civil or criminal action to which the petitioners may be found liable, under the law.
