2. On the asking of the Court, Mr. V.G. Jauhar, Senior D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Let a copy of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

3. The petitioner, who is a woman, has challenged the order passed by Ld. Judge Special Court, Moga, on 16.08.2017, vide which the bail earlier granted to her was cancelled and coercive process was issued against her.

4. The petitioner's contention before this Court is that she could not appear on that solitary date as there was some miscommunication on the

part of her Advocate's Clerk, regarding the actual date of appearance and, as such, her absence was not intentional. She further undertakes to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court forthwith and seeks interim protection of this Court.

5. From the impugned order itself, it transpires that the next date fixed before the Ld. Trial Court is 14.09.2017.

6. In the circumstances, the matter is disposed off by staying operation of the impugned order with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court by 13.09.2017, in which case her fresh application for bail may be considered favourably.
