Ld. counsel for the petitioners draws attention to the specific averment made in ground 'F' on Page No. 17 to the effect that an application for exemption was actually filed in the Ld. Court below, even though the Ld. Trial Magistrate in her impugned order dated 02.08.2017 (Annexure P-1) had observed:

*“no such application for exemption
application. Application stand dismissed.”*

2. Visibly such order appears to have been passed in a mechanical manner, considering the manifest grammatical errors in the entire order.
3. Ld. counsel for the petitioners undertakes that all his clients will positively appear before the Ld. Trial Court on the next date fixed, i.e.

13.09.2017.

4. In view of such undertaking, the instant petition is allowed. The impugned order passed by the Ld. Trial Court is set aside with a direction upon all the petitioners to positively appear before the said Court on the date fixed, failing which the Court shall be at liberty to take appropriate action.

5. Disposed off.
