As per prosecution, the alleged recovery effected from the present petitioner as also co-accused is of 300 vials of Corex syrup, 300 veils of Rexcof and 1498 strips of Spasmo proxyvon.

In the light of such alleged heavy and commercial recovery, this Court would not be inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner the benefit of regular bail.

The instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is, accordingly, declined.

However, keeping in the view the fact that the petitioner has faced incarceration since 02.04.2014, directions are issued to the trial Court to make an endeavour to expedite the conclusion of the trial.
