ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 93, dated 05.09.2015, under Sections 307/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the incident took place in broad day light at 10:00 a.m. on 19.08.2015 yet the petitioner was named by the complainant after 20 days on 05.09.2015. He also contends that in the statement made by the complainant on the day of the accident itself, he had stated that he had met with an accident and nobody is to be blamed for it. He also contends that all the injuries sustained by the complainant are simple in nature and he has fully recovered. He also states that the petitioner is in custody for over six months since the date of his arrest on 07.03.2017.

Heard.

The petitioner was named in the statement of the complainant recorded after 20 days and he has been in custody for over six months. Only simple injuries have been caused to the complainant. In the initial statement of the complainant recorded on the date of the accident itself, he had stated that he had met with an accident and nobody is to be blamed. Therefore, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
