Report dated 25.09.2017 sent by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nihal Singh Wala has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Sukhi @ Sukhwinder Singh, Lashman Singh, Nirbahi Singh, Manjit Singh as well as of complainant Gurpreet Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

under Sections 323,427,341,506,148,149 IPC, Police Station, Nihal Singh
Wala, District Moga and all other consequential proceedings arising
therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
