Petitioners-Vicky Saroa, Raj Kumar, Vijay, Neeta @ Chanchal Kumar Neet, Satpal and Shankar have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in a cross-case registered vide G.D. No.21 dated 12.05.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 148, 149 and 120-B of IPC in FIR No.69 dated 08.05.2016, registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar Rural, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 427, 436, 148 and 149 of IPC.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, the petitioners are named in the FIR and simple injuries have been attributed to them. It is a case of version and cross-version and it is yet to be determined by the trial Court on the basis of evidence as to who is the aggressor party.

Moreover, in pursuance of the interim order dated 07.09.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 07.09.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
