The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 209 dated 14.07.2015, under Sections 406 and 498-A of the IPC, registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

By an order dated 11.07.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for exploring the possibility of an amicable settlement. Vide report of the Mediator dated 02.08.2017, the matter seems to be settled between the parties.

Learned Assistant A.G., Punjab, for the respondent-State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that petitioner has already joined the investigation and cooperating and he is not required for

any custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed and order dated 03.11.2015, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438, Sub Section (2) Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
