The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.12 dated 02.08.2017 under Sections 420/467/468/471 IPC, registered at Police Station Women, Police Station Khanpur, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner are that he had submitted a fake B.A Certificate at the time of appointment as Assistant Security Officer and the petitioner has already been removed from the job. He further contends that all the documents are with the police and the petitioner will render all cooperation to the police.

This Court, by the order dated 07.09.2017 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his

arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Shiri Krishan, states that in pursuance to the order dated 07.09.2017, the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 07.09.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
