Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.101 dated 12.04.2017 registered under Sections 147, 148, 341, 325, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station South Sector-34, UT, Chandigarh, on the basis of compromise Annexure-P2.

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 07.09.2017 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court and the Juvenile Justice Board for recording their statements with a direction to the trial Court and the Juvenile Justice Board to furnish their respective reports qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh and Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Chandigarh, on 15.09.2017 and got recorded their statements. Reports from the concerned Judicial Magistrate vide covering letter bearing No.247 dated 15.09.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Chandigarh vide letter bearing No.DSJ-EC-2017/11468 dated 16.09.2017 as well as the Principal Magistrate vide letter bearing No.320 dated 18.09.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Chandigarh vide Endst. No.DSJ-EC-2017/11538 dated 19.09.2017 have been received.

According to the aforesaid reports, the compromise between the parties is genuine outcome of their free consent and without any coercion, undue influence or pressure.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.101, is quashed qua the petitioners only.
