Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda on the basis of compounding/compromise. Pursuant to the order dated 08.11.2016, report of the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phul has been received who has recorded the statements of the parties and reported that the compromise has been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion.
