INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Shakti has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.144 dated 02.05.2016, registered at Police Station Sadar Sonipat, District Sonipat, under Sections 186, 307, 353 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, the petitioner has been named in the FIR. He was armed with countrymade pistol and fired from it, but the bullet did not hit anybody. It is a case of no injury.

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The petitioner has been in custody since 02.05.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
