The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.257 dated 01.08.2017 registered under Sections 420 & 483 IPC at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala.

Learned trial Court has recorded factual aspects and reasons for rejecting the plea for anticipatory bail. I quote para 6 thereof, which reads thus:

“6. Instant FIR was lodged on the written complaint filed by Varun Vohra, Manager, Kotak Mohindra Bank. In the complaint it is alleged that applicant took loan from Kotak Mohindera Bank for purchasing tanker but after paying a few

installments applicant stopped paying it and he wrongly alleged that his tanker was forcibly taken into possession by the officials of the bank. On 1.8.2017 officials of the bank found that applicant through his driver was plying the aforesaid tanker under fake registration number by affixing number plate of PB-11BF-5310. Since the RC and permit found in the said tanker belongs to tanker having chasis No.MAT466422D5A00830 and engine no.31A63309566 while in fact tanker was having chasis no.MAT466422D5A00594 and engine No.21K84083211 which on verification from transport authority found having registration No.PB-11BK-1293 which was taken on loan from the complainant bank.”

I agree with the above reasons given by the learned trial Court. In that view of the matter, I am not inclined to further extend the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. In the result the petition for anticipatory bail is dismissed. Interim order dated 07.09.2017 is vacated.
