Through this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for grant of regular bail pending trial to petitioner Amit @ Golu in case F.I.R. No.211 dated 18.06.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 325, 326,, 307, 452 and 506 IPC and Sections 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Madlauda, District Panipat.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he opened fire in the air with his gun.

Learned counsel inter-alia contends that the petitioner was not named in the F.I.R. No role whatsoever has been attributed to him in causing injury to complainant Bijender.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondent-State vehemently opposed the prayer for bail to the petitioner.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petitioner is admitted to regular bail during trial, subject to his furnishing bail/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
