The present petition has been filed under Section 438 the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 99 dated 23.10.2016 registered under Sections 326, 323 and 324 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Chatiwind, Amritsar.

On 08.03.2017 this Court had passed the following order:-

“Contends that it is a case of version and cross version. The cross version of the petitioner has not been accepted by the police. Aggrieved against, one Jaswinder Singh, relative of the petitioner has filed a complaint (Annexure P-3) to the concerned authority. He further states that the occurrence took place on 11.10.2016 whereas the FIR came to be registered on 23.10.2016.

Post again on 24.04.2017.

The petitioner is directed to join the investigation.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 08.03.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 08.03.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
