Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.240 dated 07.09.2016 under Sections 323, 341, 148, 149 IPC and u/s 326/ 324 IPC added later on registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to the order dated 08.09.2017 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 22.09.2017 to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.101 dated 26.09.2017.

According to the report, the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is genuine, voluntary, and without any inducement, threat or pressure. None of the accused has been declared proclaimed offender in this case.

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dated 26.09.2017 and the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No.240 dated 07.09.2016 registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
