Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.70 dated 10.07.2017 under Sections 323, 324, 34 of IPC (Sections 325, 326 of IPC were added lateron vide rapat dated 16.07.2017), registered at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 08.09.2017 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Jaswinder Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 23.11.2017 and her custodial interrogation is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 08.09.2017 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
