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Petitioner-Balbir Singh @ Mani @ Cheema has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.85 dated 25.10.2014, registered at Police Station Babain, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 148, 302, 323 and 324 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

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I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the statement of Avtar Singh. As per the allegations, the present petitioner is named in the FIR. He is stated to be armed with sword. He has taken the active participation in the commission of the offence.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of nature and gravity of the offence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.

However, as the petitioner has been in custody since 07.12.2014, trial Court is directed to dispose of the case expeditiously by giving short adjournments or even by adjourning the case on day to day basis, if necessary. Investigating Officer/Station House Officer of the concerned police station is directed to produce the remaining witnesses before the trial Court at the earliest.
