Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.113 dated 27.07.2017, under Sections 406, 409, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 13(1)(d) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station City Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, Punjab. This Court had made an order dated 08.09.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from police official states that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custody is not required.

In that view of the matter, interim order dated 08.09.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
