The petitioner is seeking a direction to the official respondents not to pressurize him to enter into a compromise with respondent No. 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the police officials are forcing the petitioner to enter into compromise with respondent No. 5. He has drawn my attention to the representation dated 04.09.2017 sent by him to respondent No. 2 and contends that the petitioner will be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider his representation dated 04.09.2017 (Annexure P-3).

Without making any observations on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to look into the representation dated 04.09.2017 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner and take action, if necessary, in accordance with law expeditiously.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
