This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.101 dated 17.06.2016, under Sections 420 and 406 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

Allegations in a nutshell are with regard to a forged and fabricated Will having been set up and on the strength of which land of the complainant was transferred.

Insofar as the present petitioner is concerned, his role is stated to be that of an attesting witness. He is not stated to be the beneficiary of the Will.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Surjit Singh apprises the Court that the petitioner has already joined investigation.

Under such circumstances, custodial interrogation of the petitioner would not be warranted.

Prayer made in the petition is accepted. Order dated 06.10.2016, passed by this Court is made absolute.
