The petitioner prays for quashing of FIR No. 262 dated 13.7.2012 for offence under Sections 498-A, 406, 506 of the Indian Penal Code (in short "IPC") registered at Police Station, Model Town, District Rewari.

Counsel for the State of Haryana, on instructions from HC Sanjay Kumar would apprise the court that on completion of investigation, challan was presented in the Court and one witness was examined. When the case was fixed for remaining evidence of the prosecution, the present petitioner absented from the proceedings and has been declared as a proclaimed offender vide order dated 21.10.2016.

In view of statement made by counsel for the State, the petitioner is not entitled to indulgence of this Court in exercise of

extraordinary jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
