The instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 for fair and impartial investigation in FIR No. 317 dated 24.08.2017, under Sections 323, 406, 354, 498-A and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar. In this regard the petitioner has already approached the authorities by way of representation dated 25.08.2017 (Annexure P-4)
