Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.40 dated 06.04.2015 under Sections 21/22 NDPS Act registered at Police Station "C" Division, District Amritsar.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate in Court, which is taken on record. On the strength of the custody certificate, he submits that the petitioner is involved in three more cases. In FIR No.118/14 under Sections 21/22 NDPS Act and Sections

379/411 IPC, P.S. Kotwali, Amritsar and FIR No.113/14 under Sections 302/307/148/149/120-B IPC and Section 25 Arms Act P.S. Sultanwind, Amritsar, the petitioner is on bail whereas in FIR No.44/14 under Sections 21/22 NDPS Act, P.S. "C" Division, Amritsar, he has been convicted and sentenced to undergo RI for one month along with fine.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that the petitioner is involved in number of cases, no case for grant of bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed
