Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.1 and 2 to transfer the investigation in case FIR No.39 dated 01.06.2017 under Sections 323, 325 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Kotwali Nabha, District Patiala.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. A.S. Dhaliwal, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

The FIR in question was registered on 01.06.2017 and it being a dispute between the petitioner-wife and respondent No.5-husband, no interference is warranted for transfer of investigation by this Court

However, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala is directed to look into the contents of representation dated 28.08.2017 (Annexure P-4) moved by the petitioner and to act in accordance with law.

The petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
